

**Assistant Professor – Natural Resource Economics and Policy, University of Florida

12-month position with tenure accruing in the School of Forest Resources and Conservation & joint appointment in Food and Resource Economics. Assigned responsibilities will be 40% teaching/60% research. Duties include: (1) teaching two undergraduate classes each year, Natural Resource Economics (AEB 3450) and Natural Resources Policy and Administration (FNR 4660C); (2) teaching or team teaching one or two graduate classes in the candidate's specialty; (3) chairing and serving on graduate committees in both units, supervising thesis and dissertation research, supervising undergraduate research, and publishing with his/her graduate students; (4) engaging in other scholarly activities related to instruction; and (5) establishing a well-funded, internationally recognized research program in natural resource economics and policy, with preferred emphasis on investigating economic, political, social, and ecological implications of natural resource policies and management alternatives at local to global levels. Example approaches could include market and non-market valuation, full-cost accounting and life cycle analyses. An earned doctorate in natural resource economics, natural resource policy and administration, or a closely related discipline is required. Candidates should have at least one degree in a natural resources related field and have demonstrated potential for excellence in teaching. Postdoctoral experience is desirable.
