**Research Scientist** - The Gulf of Maine Research Institute (GMRI) is seeking candidates to fill a Research Scientist position in **Marine Resource Economics**. The successful candidate will be involved in a team-oriented research program on the marine ecosystem in the Gulf of Maine region. Research Scientists are responsible for maintaining active, high-quality research programs with extramural funding, assisting with the translation of research results for education and application, and participating as active members of GMRI. Research Scientists report directly to the Chief Scientific Officer.

The Gulf of Maine Research Institute catalyzes solutions to the complex challenges of ocean stewardship and economic growth in the Gulf of Maine bioregion through a dynamic fusion of science, education, and community. The successful candidate will join a team of eight other Research Scientists who primarily focus on fishery ecosystem research in the Gulf of Maine. GMRI moved into its new marine research facility on the waterfront in Portland, Maine in mid-January 2005.

Candidates must have earned a doctoral degree and have an established research record in an appropriate scientific discipline. Candidates will have an interest in applied research and policy analysis relating to management of marine resources and marine ecosystem services and expertise and experience in one or more of the following areas - bioeconomic modeling; non-market valuation of marine ecosystem services; incentive based approaches to managing human activities in the marine environment, particularly fishing; and economics of marine spatial planning.
