

The Department of Economics at Oberlin College invites applications for a full-time, non-continuing faculty position starting Fall 2010. Preferences will be given to candidates who have demonstrated successful teaching or scholarly research in the area of environmental or resource economics. Teaching duties include two intermediate or upper-level applied courses and a seminar in these topic areas, and two sections of principle, intermediate theory or econometrics. The incumbent is expected to have earned a Ph.D. in Economics, Agricultural Economics or Resource Economics or have expectations of completing the degree by August 2010. Successful teaching experience and policy analysis are both desirable. Salary and benefits are commensurate with the individual's qualifications and experience.
