**Position Summary:** The Center for Environmental and Resource Economic Policy (CEnREP), Department of Agricultural and Resource Economics, North Carolina State University, is seeking candidates for a Post-Doctoral Research Associate position. Candidates should be interested in pursuing collaborative water resources research with CEnREP affiliated faculty and their collaborators in the Environmental Finance Center at UNC-Chapel Hill.

**Position Responsibilities:** The person in this position will be encouraged to pursue their research interests in conjunction with Center faculty, and UNC-system researchers. Collaboration on Center projects and service is anticipated.

**Qualifications:** The candidate must have a Ph.D. in agricultural economics, economics, or a related field at the time of appointment. The ideal candidate would possess strong microeconometrics skills and have a strong interest in pursuing collaborative research relating to water resource management. However, all outstanding candidates with interests in environmental and natural resource economics will be considered.

**Salary and Length of Appointment:** Salary is commensurate with qualifications. This is a 12-month, fiscal-year position and is a 100% research appointment. The initial appointment would be for one year and is expected to be renewed for a second year.
