A: Most general sessions will consist of 4 papers. Each presenter will have approximately 17 minutes for the presentation followed by 4-5 minutes for questions. The order of presentations will follow the order listed on the program. Unless otherwise noted, the session chair will be the first presenter in each session, and the chair will be responsible for keeping the session on schedule and providing a laptop for the session. Presenters are not required to provide or upload full papers prior to the conference. Please upload your presentation on the laptop prior to the start of the session.

Q: I am presenting a paper in a sponsored session. Can you please tell me the format for the session?

Sponsored sessions will consist of 3 papers. Each paper will also have a discussant. Presenters will give a 17-minute presentation, followed by an 8 minute discussion and then there will be approximately 5 minutes for questions. Please send your discussant, listed in the attached document, your paper no later than May 17. Unless otherwise noted, the session chair will be the first presenter in each session, and the chair will be responsible for keeping the session on schedule and providing a laptop for the session. Please upload your presentation on the laptop prior to the start of the session.
